



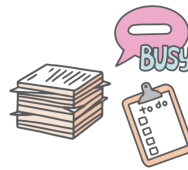

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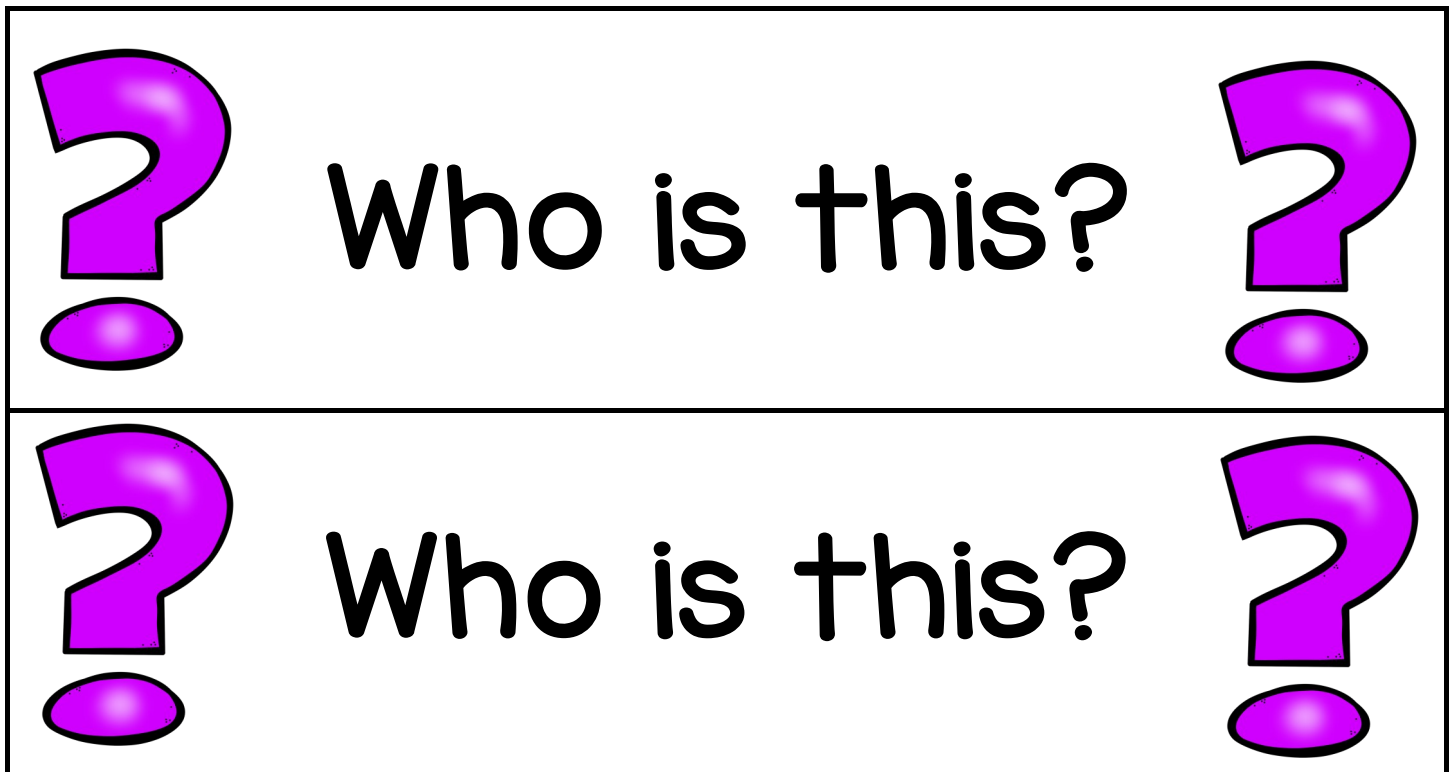

Use these labels for using your student silhouette pictures to help students work on learning classmate's name and answering "who" questions. See [this blog post](#) for more information.



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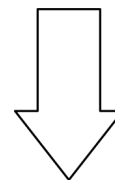

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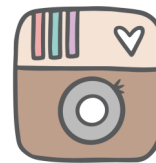
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
